Aberdeen City Council (City Centre) Amendment Order 2025 (“City Centre AQMA Order”)

Order amending an Air Quality Management Area (AQMA)

Whereas Aberdeen City Council (“The Council”) having caused to be conducted a review and assessment of air quality in City Centre Air Quality Management Area is satisfied that the air quality objectives in respect of Particles (PM₁₀) annual mean and 24 hour objectives as specified in the Air Quality (Scotland) Regulations 2000 (as amended by the Air Quality (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2002 and 2016) will be met in the area described in the Schedule below for reasons of previous current and projected compliance with the relevant air quality objectives.

The Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 83(2) of the Environment Act 1995 hereby makes the following Amendment Order for the City Centre AQMA designated in 2018.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The AQMA known as City Centre AQMA designated for a likely breach of the Nitrogen Dioxide annual mean objective and the Particles (PM₁₀) annual mean and 24 hour objectives and as described in the Schedule below shall be amended to revoke the Particles (PM₁₀) annual mean and 24 hour objectives.
2. The Order shall be cited as the Aberdeen City Council (City Centre) Air Quality Management Area Amendment Order 2025.
3. The order shall come into force on 1 February 2025
4. The Order shall remain in force until varied or revoked by subsequent Order.

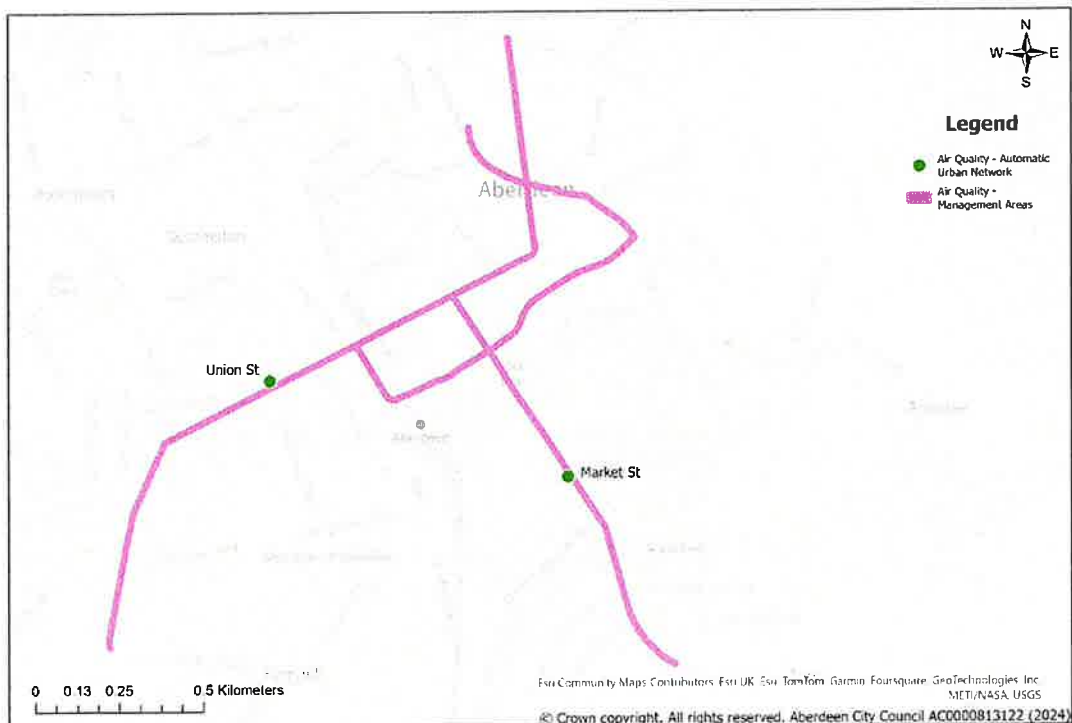

Schedule to the Aberdeen City Council (City Centre) Air Quality Management Area Amendment Order 2025

The designated area shown shaded in purple on the attached map and known as the City Centre AQMA shall be amended to revoke the Particles (PM₁₀) annual mean and 24 hour objectives.

The designated area consists of the following locations:

Market Street, Union Street, King Street (between Castle Street and Roslin Terrace), Virginia Street, Commerce Street, Guild Street, Bridge Street, Holburn Street (between Great Southern Road and Union Street), Victoria Road, Torry (between Queen Elizabeth II Bridge and Crombie Road) and West North Street (King Street to 100m north of junction with Littlejohn Street).
